# What reselling actually is

Reselling is exactly what it sounds like: you buy something at one price, and you sell it for more. That's it. No factory, no inventory warehouse, no business degree.

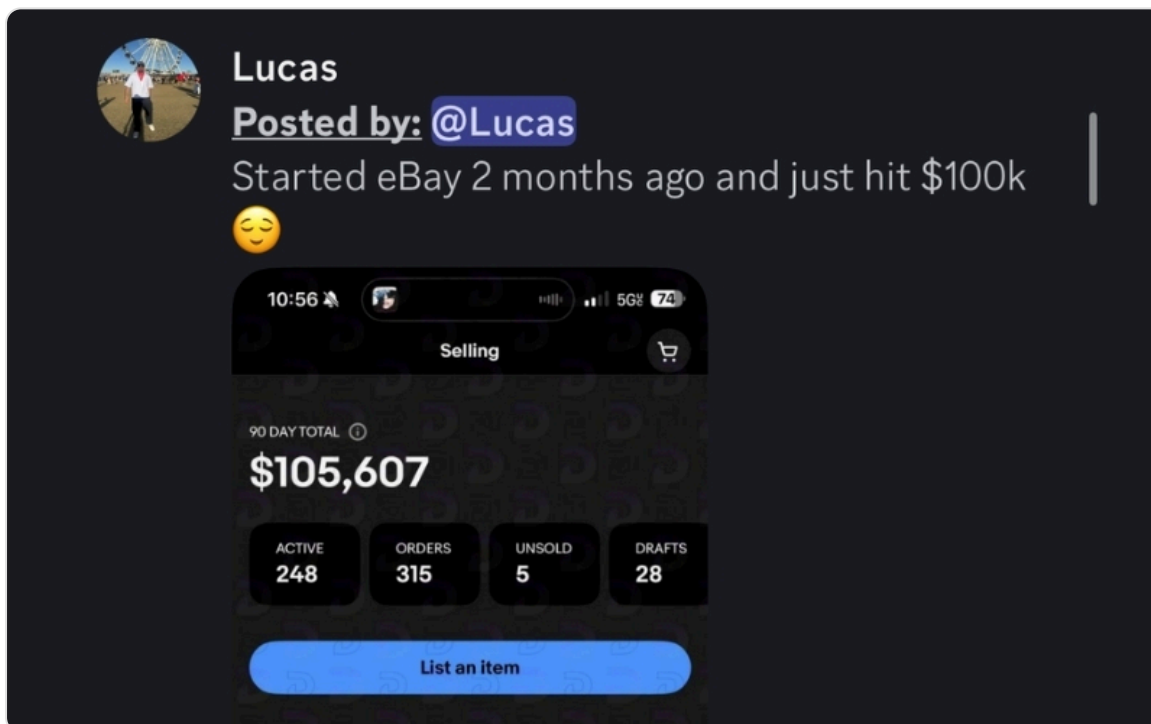

## Set up Free Autocheckout (ACO)

This is the tool that **does the actual fighting for you**. Set it up before a drop happens, not during it. For example, if a limited sneaker is restocking at 9:00 AM, ACO is already watching and ready to **buy automatically** the second it's available — while everyone else is still refreshing the page by hand.

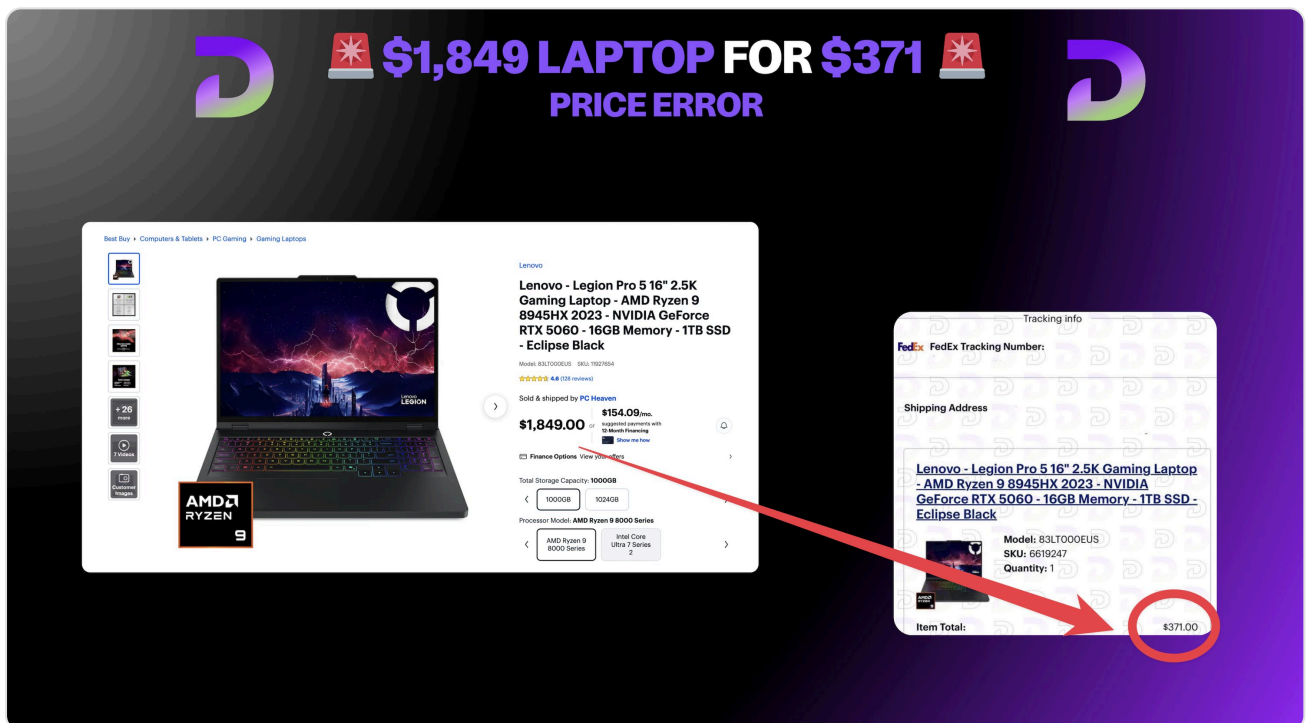

## Turn on price error and clearance alerts

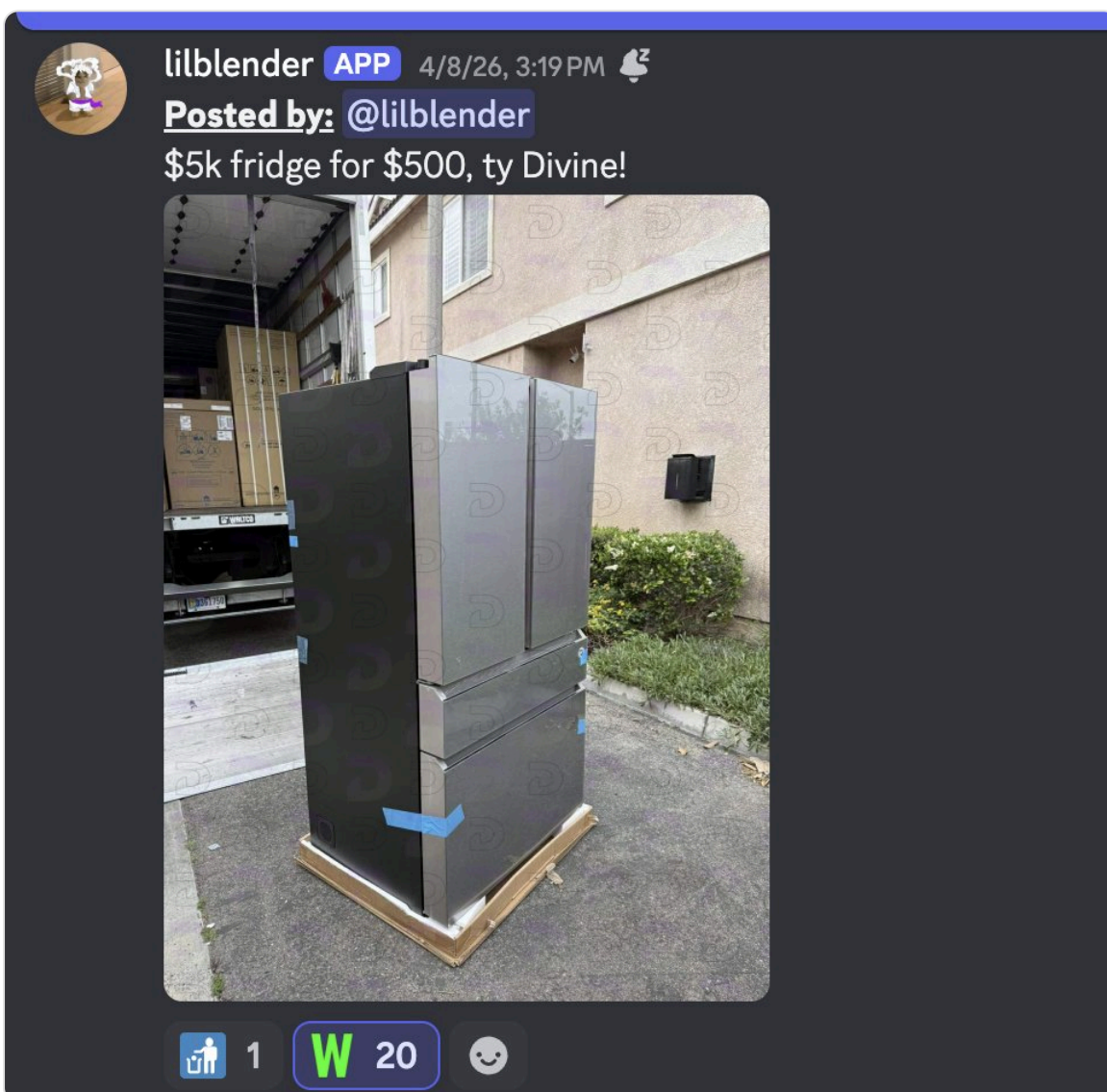
These alerts catch mistakes before stores fix them. For example, a retailer might accidentally list a \$150 item for \$15 due to a system glitch — the alert tells you the moment it's spotted, so you can buy it within minutes, long before the price gets corrected.



# 04

## Buy the item at retail price

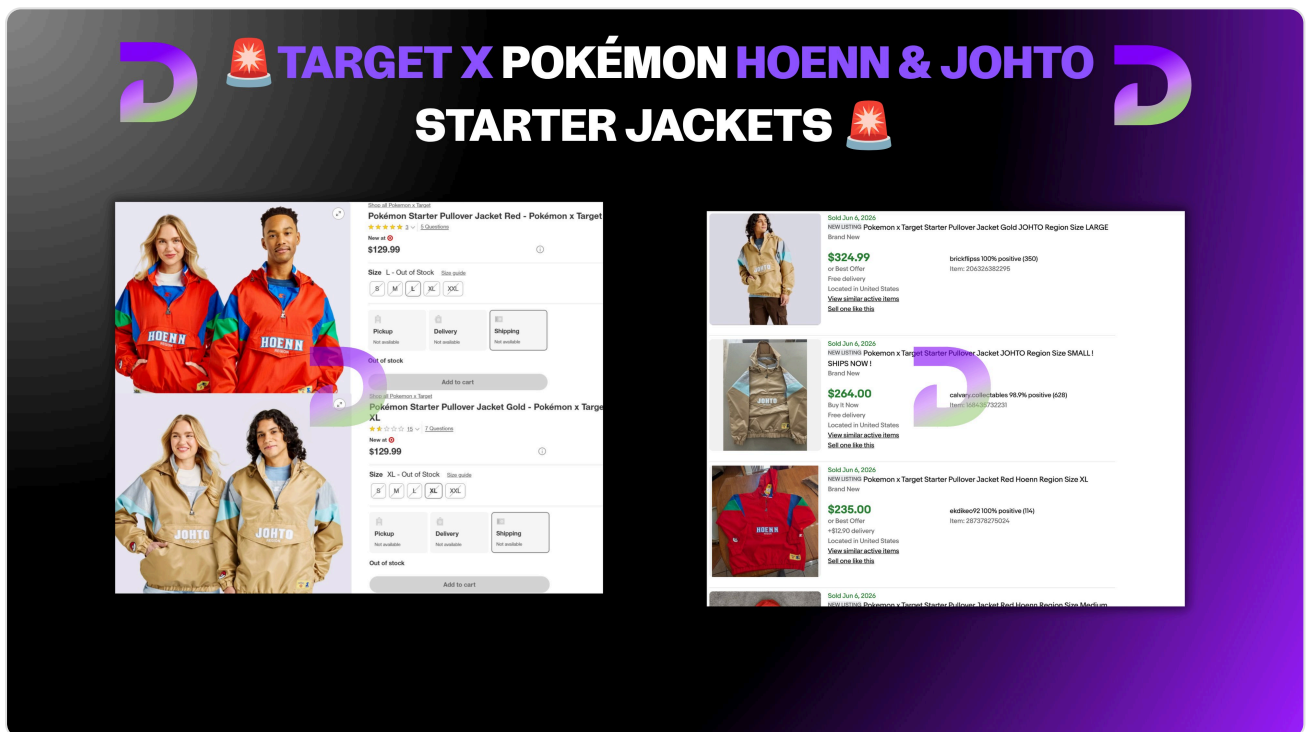
Whether ACO secured it automatically or you caught a clearance deal yourself, this purchase is your **cost basis**. For example, if you pick up a pair of sneakers at the \$120 retail price, that \$120 is what you'll measure your eventual profit against.



# 05

## List it where it sells best

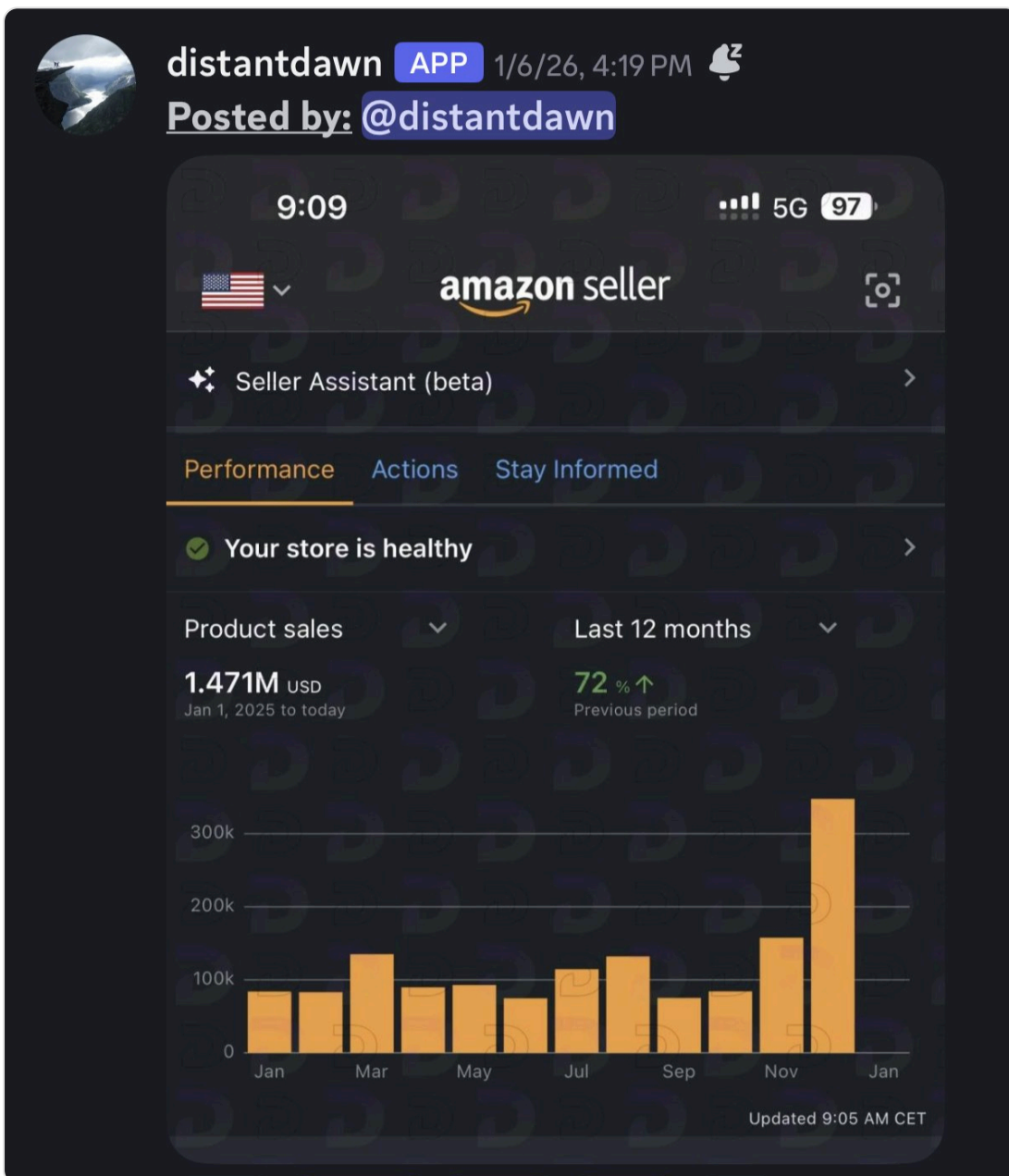
Different items sell better on different platforms. For example, sneakers tend to move fast on **StockX**, while collectibles and trading cards often do better on **eBay**. Use the pricing guidance shared inside the community so you list at a price that actually sells instead of sitting for weeks.



# 06

## Ship it and track your profit

Once it sells, package it well and ship promptly — your reviews depend on it. For example, if you bought an item for \$120 and sold it for \$180, your **profit** is \$60 minus fees and shipping. **Track every flip** so you can see which categories are actually working for you.



## 07

## Reinvest and ask The Network when stuck

---

Put a portion of every profit back into your next purchase — this is how one flip becomes a **repeatable cycle** instead of a one-time win. For example, turning that \$60 profit into the budget for your next two items compounds quickly. And if something doesn't make sense, ask inside **The Network** — veteran resellers are there to help beginners avoid the mistakes they already made.

**WHAT'S REALISTIC**

Your first flip might only profit \$20–\$50 — that's normal. The goal early on is learning the cycle. Resellers who stay consistent for a few months commonly reach \$500–\$2,000/month in profit.
